Today you were interviewed regarding your petition to remove the conditions on your residence by DAO R. Corsello. The results of your interview are the following:

- Your petition to remove the conditions on residence, Form I-751, has been approved. You can expect to receive your Permanent Resident Card within 180 days. In the interim you have been issued a stamp evidencing the approval of your permanent resident status. The stamp is authorization for employment. Travel is also authorized, provided you have a valid passport prior to departing the US.
- A request for additional documentation has been made on Form I-72. You are accorded 87 days, by law, in which to submit all of the requested documentation at one time, or your application may be denied. Please allow an additional 60 days from receipt of the requested documentation before you make an inquiry so we may review the evidence submitted and advise you accordingly of a decision.
- Your case is being held for file review in order to prepare a denial of your application. You will be advised by mail as to the decision within 180 days of today's interview date. Please do not submit other documents or information until you have received the decision as it can not be accepted.
- Your case is being rescheduled for another interview. You will be advised within 120 days as to the date and time to appear for the second interview.
- Your case is being held for file review and you will receive a decision within 180 days. You do not need to submit any additional information at this time.
- A review of your file indicates that you meet the residence time requirements to apply for naturalization.
